

Theorem: "There is no god".

Abstract. *There is no god.*

Definition. God (the god; it). The god is an omnipotent construct. Omnipotence means two abilities:

1. To know everything (complete knowledge).
2. To influence everything (complete control).

Theorem. There is no god.

Proof. Let us show that the abilities 1 and 2 contradict each other.

Indeed, the ability 1 includes in particular the knowledge of the future. This knowledge makes the future predefined, not controllable, thus rendering the ability 2 impossible.

Vice versa, the ability 2 suggests an existence of choice of a future making it unknown. This contradicts the ability 1.

We see that either the god knows the future and has no choice in making decisions or it has such a choice and because of that does not know the not yet chosen future.

Either complete knowledge or complete control, but not simultaneously. Hence the existence of the god is not possible.
